- 2000 PedNet Coalition founded on Earth Day.
- 2002 First Bike Walk and Wheel Week held. 750 Columbians took part.
- 2004: Passed Street Design Standards ordinance to ensure safe access for all travel modes on all new streets.
- 2005: Helped pass a \$3.5 million sales tax for sidewalks around schools.
- 2006: Attracted to Columbia a \$22 million federal Non-Motorized Transportation Pilot Program grant.
- 2008: Awarded national leading site grant for "Healthy Kids, Healthy Communities".
- 2010: 6,450 people joined Honorary Chair Carl Edwards in taking the Mayor's Challenge: Bike, Walk, and Wheel Week.
- 2010: First Unite 4 Healthy Neighborhoods summit focuses on improving health outcomes for underserved populations.
